



TRIPLE P PRACTICE EXCELLENCE AWARD

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

The purpose of this award is to recognize an accredited individual Triple P practitioner who exhibits excellence and innovation in the implementation of Triple P. The award will serve as recognition of outstanding contribution and commitment to the delivery of Triple P.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Demonstration of excellence in practice, or service directly or indirectly resulting in improved client outcomes and/or advancement of Triple P. Anyone who wishes to be considered for the prize should write a 1-page summary document briefly addressing the following:

- Outcomes: Evidence of enhanced outcomes (e.g., client outcomes, number of families affected) following implementation
- Innovation: Demonstrates innovation in the implementation of Triple P AND adherence to Triple P
- Vision & leadership: Demonstrates leadership in fostering an environment that is conducive to the delivery of Triple P at a population level

AWARD ELIGIBILITY

An organisation, supervisor, or colleague can nominate a practitioner for the award. Any Triple P accredited provider is eligible for this award. Triple P International staff are not eligible for the award. Only individuals are able to receive this award and team or group nominations will not be considered.

AWARD DESCRIPTION

The recipient of this award shall receive a specially designed plaque and a selection of Triple P materials. In addition, the recipient will receive recognition at the Helping Families Change Conference.

NOMINATION COMPLETION AND SUBMISSION

All nominations must be fully completed and submitted to the Parenting and Family Support Centre by the nomination deadline in order for the nominee to be considered as a candidate for the award.
